Good afternoon,

Welcome back after spring break! Every year March seems to creep along, and then you turn around and it's May. This year was no different, so we're gearing up for our end of year activities.

Recently we administered our second Terrace Metrics assessment of the year to our fifth through eighth graders. Here is a brief summary from our counselor, Ms. Wilson:

For some background, for grades 6,7, and 8, the assessment is looking at 7 main indicators of overall behavioral health and well being, and grade 5 looks at 3. Overall, results were pretty consistent and similar within each grade. At St. Henry our resounding strengths in each grade were positive school experiences and global satisfaction, meaning that students focus on things they can control and report more positive experiences. This is very promising and shows that kids feel safe, happy and healthy in school. It also shows that they really enjoy school (even when they may not admit it!).

On May 9 our student council will be hosting a bake sale to support Ukraine. They will be organizing and leading it, then collecting and sending the money. Thanks to the student council for taking this on!

At this time we are postponing our talent show. We want to give some more time for our children to develop their acts, so be on the lookout for a new date. Any questions should be sent to Mr. Tieman.

#### **P-EBT Cards**

Kentucky has been approved to provide P-EBT benefits for the 2021-2022 school year. For a student to be eligible for the 2021-2022 P-EBT benefits, a student must attend a school participating in the National School Lunch Program AND must be eligible to receive free/reduced meals (includes all students at CEP schools). To receive these benefits, you must apply for free/reduced lunch at <u>lunchapplication.com</u> before the end of this school year if you haven't applied this school year. If approved, these benefits will be carried over for the first 30 school days next year.
