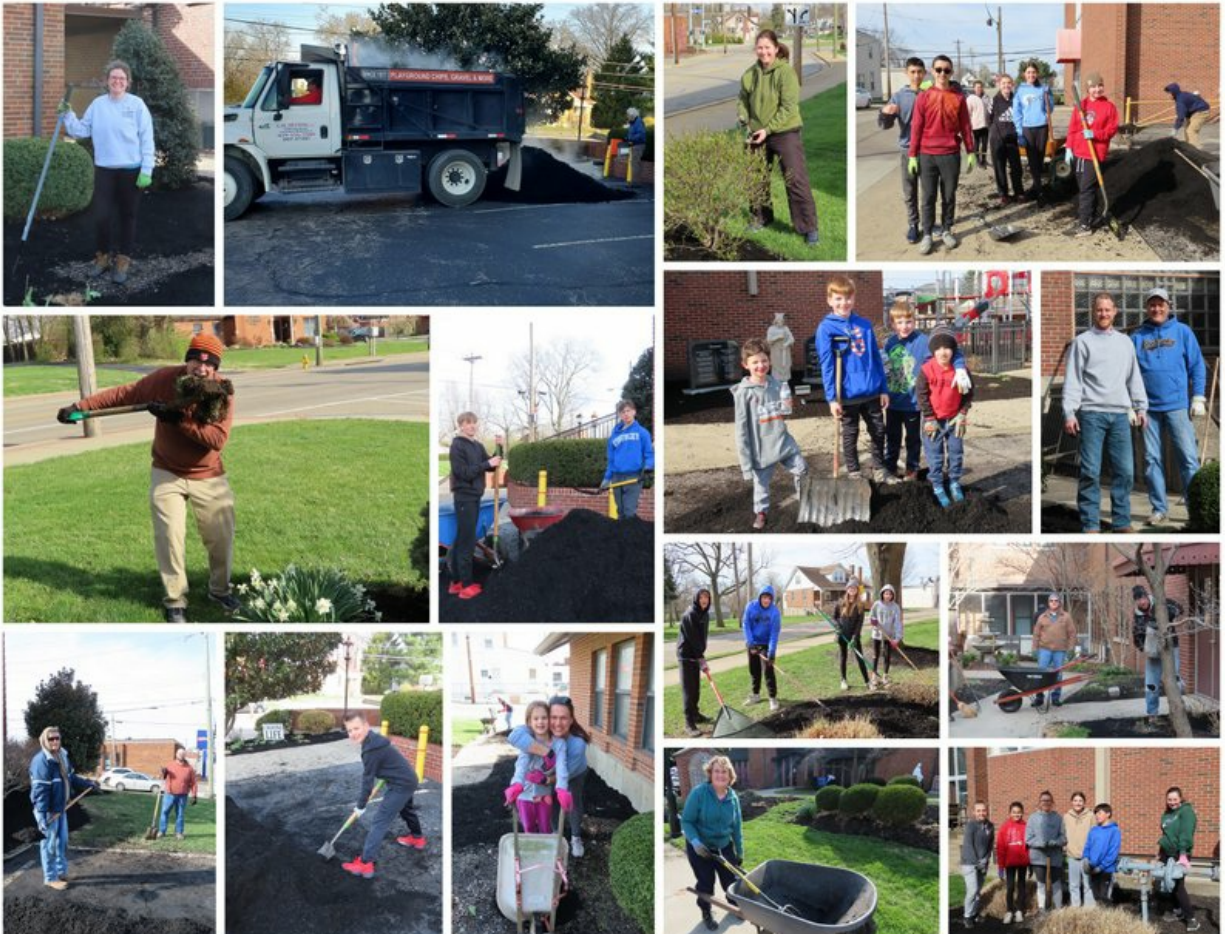
Eric Genuis Performance

P-EBT Cards

Kentucky has been approved to provide P-EBT benefits for the 2021-2022 school year. For a student to be eligible for the 2021-2022 P-EBT benefits, a student must attend a school participating in the National School Lunch Program AND must be eligible to receive free/reduced meals (includes all students at CEP schools). To receive these benefits, you must apply for free/reduced lunch at lunchapplication.com before the end of this school year if you haven't applied this school year. If approved, these benefits will be carried over for the first 30 school days next year.
