#### **Chrism Mass**

Eighth graders and candidates for Confirmation, Trey Fedders, William Miller, and Hunter Strasinger attended the Chrism Mass Tuesday evening at the Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption on behalf of St. Henry. The Chrism Mass is a gathering of all the priests of the Diocese of Covington, along with representatives from each of the parishes. At this liturgy, the priests renew the promises that they made at their ordination. Then the bishop blesses the three sacred oils that will be used throughout the coming year: the Oil of Catechumens, the Oil of the Sick, and the Sacred Chrism, from which the liturgy gets its name. At the end of the Chrism Mass, the oils are distributed to the representatives from the parishes.

#### **P-EBT Cards**

Kentucky has been approved to provide P-EBT benefits for the 2021-2022 school year. For a student to be eligible for the 2021-2022 P-EBT benefits, a student must attend a school participating in the National School Lunch Program AND must be eligible to receive free/reduced meals (includes all students at CEP schools). To receive these benefits, you must apply for free/reduced lunch at <u>lunchapplication.com</u> before the end of this school year if you haven't applied this school year. If approved, these benefits will be carried over for the first 30 school days next year.
