2021-2022 School Calendar

Good afternoon!

We're looking forward to seeing new families tonight and everyone Sunday at Readyfest beginning at 12:30. Please remember, masks are required at this time indoors, so wear your mask in the building.

This year we will operate the same arrival times that we did pre-Covid:

- 7:00 AM doors open for early arrival, students wait in the cafeteria
- 7:25 7:40 AM arrival begins, students go to their classrooms
- Students arriving after 7:40 AM will be tardy and need to report to the office before going to class

You will also see at Readyfest that 5th - 8th grade is back in the old high school building and KG - 4th grade is back in the middle building. Students should enter the doors of their respective building.

More information is below about dismissal. Afternoon announcements will begin at 2:30 PM, with dismissal to follow immediately.

If you ordered an EduKit, we just got word that they have been delayed in shipping. We expect them to arrive Monday, so will distribute them for students to begin use on Tuesday.

If you ordered spiritwear to be ready by Readyfest, it will be in the cafeteria on Sunday during Readyfest. There will also be extra items in the cafeteria for sale for those that are interested.

As a reminder, be sure to send student information needed for students' cumulative files. Needed items include up-to-date immunizations records, birth certificate, social security card and / or baptismal certificates, if applicable. This is a requirement for attendance. St. Henry, pray for us!

Covid update

This week the Department of Catholic Schools at the Diocese updated their guidance on quarantine requirements. The Governor also announced a mask mandate for schools.

The quarantine guidance includes exemptions for quarantining, as well as removes the extended 24 day quarantine period for household contacts. This and more information can be found in <u>this School Covid Requirements</u> <u>document</u>.

We expect to have an updated School Covid Requirements document early next week that includes information as it relates to the mask mandate. At that time, I will share the latest information.

Because we follow state certification guidelines, licensure and are connected to the state in other ways, we are bound by the Governor's current order. Any updates regarding this mandate will also be shared immediately. Read the Governor's order <u>here</u>.

2021-22 Dismissal plan

This year's dismissal will look similar to last year's in that we will stagger when the students come outside. We're going to start this year with junior high students so those staying for homework academy can begin immediately without distraction. Parents of junior high students, please park closest to the buildings.

Next our kindergarten and first grade students will dismiss with siblings. Parents, please park in the middle.

Our last group will be our second through fifth grade students and siblings, and anyone wishing to pick up in the latest wave.

As we begin the year, please do not park closer to school because it's very crowded in that space. If you wish to arrive a few minutes later and park closer to Dixie Highway, that should be fine.
