#### **COVID19 Update**

During the month of December we've had 23 positive cases among families, students and staff. Fourteen positive cases have been students or staff. Twenty-three is the highest amount of cases we've had since the start of last year. The previous highest month was last January totaling 13 cases.

Many families have chosen the test to stay option when considered a close contact, so we've been able to keep students at school avoiding the amount of quarantine we've seen in the past.

Students that have been vaccinated avoid quarantines and tests if they are a close contact and do not have symptoms. We have some vaccination cards on file in the office. In January we will be asking families to voluntarily provide a

copy of vaccination cards to assist in contact tracing. According to the Diocese, the vaccination is not and will not be mandated; the vaccination cards are just to assist when a student is considered a close contact.

Continue to remind your children to have their masks when they come to school and remind them to wear them properly.

Thanks for everyone's continued support during all of this. There will be a time when it's behind us, but until then let's do what needs to be done.


#### **Mother/Son Cyclone Event**


