COVID UPDATE

We continued to see limited Covid activity within our school this week. Because we have seen three weeks in a row of limited activity and no known spread at school, we are going to try a new lunch routine.

Students will begin eating lunch in pods of four at the same table. There is a risk any time we loosen a guideline, including this one. During lunch students will be facing each other and of course not wearing masks. This means that if one student in the pod tests positive then the other 3 students will be required to quarantine. If a student in the pod is vaccinated and not showing symptoms, s/he will not have to quarantine.

We will monitor this, taking note of any spread or uptick in Covid activity and adjust plans accordingly.

If you have questions about this, please reach out to me. If you do not want your child at a pod during lunch, reach out to your homeroom teacher so s/he can note that in the lunch seating arrangements.

Lastly, one of our students wrote the poem below that I wanted to share given the "new normal" of remoted working.




