Table Workers: Bingo needs fun, friendly, smiling people who can count pull tabs and provide correct change to our bingo players. Duties include:

- Sell pull tabs from the table (chairs are provided and can be a seated position)
- Destroy used pull tabs
- Collate completed pull tab games
- Provide assistance to pull tab sellers on the floor by getting pull tabs set up for them to stack into their trays
- This is a fun, low key volunteer position, time commitment: 5:30-9:30 PM

Paper Sales: Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can sell bingo papers to our patrons! Training is provided and fairly simply to understand. Duties include:

- Greet customers and help customers complete bingo order forms (explain the differences between the games and the different papers)
- Ring up paper order and provide totals to customers. Collect money and provide change.
- Select and provide the proper bingo papers to customers.
- Answer general questions about game play.
- This is a fun position where you get to meet our patrons and leave early! **5:30-7:30 PM**, this position allows for some sitting. Some bending and standing is required (to select papers for patrons).

Opener: Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can help prepare early for bingo and help open the doors. Duties include:

- Prepare concessions including making coffee and putting hot-dogs on the roller grill.
- Turn on televisions.
- Prepare dauber games and sell games to patrons once doors are open.
- This is a part-time position that gets you home before Jeopardy! starts, 4:00-6:30 PM.

Volunteer benefits include:

- One night out per month and you can help St. Henry community at the same time.
- Fellowship with community members.
- Volunteer with a friend and it's a night out.
- Dinner and drinks are provided.

The sale begins on 10/11/2021 and ends at 11:59 PM on 10/25/2021.


