2022 St. Henry Catholic School Hall of Fame Inductee: Mrs. Linda Dietz

Catholic schools could not thrive without the generosity of parishioners, parents, teachers, and volunteers. St. Henry Catholic School is no exception. Since 1995, we have recognized someone who has made significant contributions to our school through the sharing of their time and talent by inducting them into the SHCS Crusader Hall of Fame during Catholic Schools Week, held the last week of January.

This year, for the first time, nominations were formally accepted from across the parish. Thank you to those of you that nominated someone for our Hall of Fame.

This year's inductee received multiple nominations for her dedication to St. Henry over the past 40 years. She'll be embarrassed to accept it, but is as worthy of a recipient as we have ever had.

Linda Dietz graduated from Holy Cross High School in 1977, then went on to Thomas More College before beginning her teaching career, all of which has taken place at St. Henry.

She has been married to her husband, Mike, for 40 years. They have three children: Elizabeth, Rachel, and Adam, all who attended St. Henry from grade school through high school. The fun is just beginning for Linda and Mike as they also have three grandchildren. Rachel followed in her mother's footsteps also becoming a teacher. I think it's safe to say that they now teach each other as much as they learn from each other as they both attended a technology conference in Orlando this past week.

Linda has taught multiple grade levels and content areas (here) at St. Henry, which means she has probably taught in every room on this campus — including the gym. She moves a lot and for that I'm sorry to Mike because he's the one coming along to help.

But it also means that she has taught about every student that has come through our doors for the last four decades. She's the kind of teacher that students come back to visit, families look forward to having her teach their child and, as a principal, you just say yes when she asks for what she needs because she's asking for the kids. Since 1981, she puts everything that she is into her work and the result is always better than ever originally expected.

Throughout her years, Mrs. Dietz has been a teacher-leader. She is a faith-filled servant keeping her Catholic values the focus of her work by leading prayers and participating in Mass as an extraordinary minister of holy communion. She is always pushing forward, striving to learn, adapt, and keeping the latest technology at the forefront of her classroom. Notably, in recent years, she has taken on ensuring that all students from preschool through eighth grade receive quality science, technology, and engineering instruction.

The few short words shared here are just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to trying to measure her immeasurable impact on St. Henry and its community. St. Henry is extremely blessed for all that Mrs. Dietz has done for our community. 


