COVID19 Update

The updated Diocesan Covid requirements states that "beginning January 24, schools may begin returning to recommended masks on a school-by-school basis when the requirements below are met:

- The school has 5-10 cases or less, and
- Cases are declining"

Our cases are declining, but we are over ten cases (as of Thursday afternoon we have 12 among students and faculty, more including our community). Because of this, we will continue in masks for at least another week.

We are in contact with each family that has a positive case to discuss symptoms and the best return date. Please keep in mind that the [Diocesan policy](#) is "if a student tests positive, he/she is to be home for ten days, with the possible

return after five days in consultation with the school." If you do not hear from me or Mrs. Spradling, please contact us.

We expect to be able to test again next week for families that are interested. To help move that process along, consider completing the consent from Wild Health now, which is linked [here](#). You will still be contacted before a test would be administered, but completing the Google form now will help speed up the process during testing.

Thanks for everyone's continued support during all of this. I'm hopeful that the decline we've seen in cases this week continues.

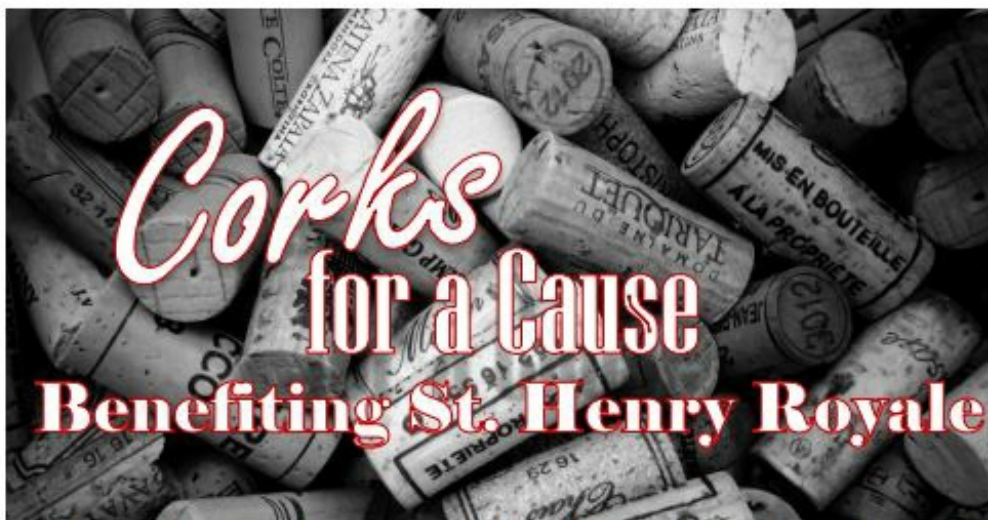

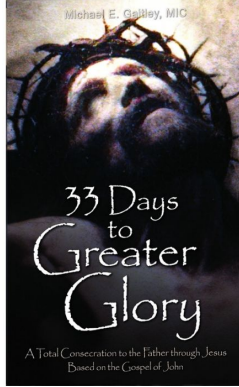

33 Days to Greater Glory

During the season of Lent, St. Henry Parish will begin *33 Days to Greater Glory: A Total Consecration to the Father through Jesus*. In this book, Fr. Michael E. Gaitley, MIC, author of *33 Days to Morning Glory*,



draws us into a relationship with the Father by exploring Jesus' own relationship with the Father through the Gospel of John. In the book's introduction, Fr. Gaitley explains, "I'm writing this book from a place of great turmoil. Based on what I'm hearing, I'm not the only one experiencing it, which comes as no surprise. After all, the turmoil is everywhere. It's in the world, in the Church, as so also, in ourselves. This 33-day retreat aims to help us overcome our turmoil with the peace and joy that the world cannot give. Before we can get to that peace and joy, however, we first need to face the turmoil."

We will begin these 33 days on Wednesday, March 12, and will conclude on Wednesday of Holy Week, April 13, with the consecration ceremony following the Tenebrae service that evening. **To order your copy of the book, email lyan@sthenryny.com or call the parish office at 859-727-2035. 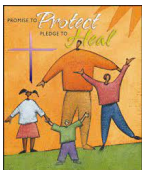
