Good afternoon,

Included in this week's update is our current staff list linked <a href="here">here</a> for the upcoming 2022-23 school year. If you're still reading this and haven't yet clicked the link, there are a few things to keep in mind when reviewing the list:

This list is as accurate as possible as we stand right now. It's possible that it could change.

We are using a good amount of our emergency COVID relief money to fund positions for next year and the year after. You'll see newly added positions that we're excited about and think will make a tremendous difference for our children. There is certainly a risk in adding positions knowing that they could be temporary, but my position is that we shouldn't avoid doing everything we can for our children while we have extra funds to support them. And we of course hope to be able to sustain some of these positions beyond the next two years.

One of the extra positions we have added is an interventionist in middle school, filled by Mr. Heister. Mr. Heister will be supporting students of all abilities in progressing academically. This opportunity will provide the chance for our children to be challenged in a way that will allow them to all grow at their pace. Specifically, it means that we will not have or need to have a middle school summer math class because students will be able to access the content during the school year.

We made two hires this past week: Tiffany Prabell has been hired as the new middle school math teacher. Rebecca Albano has been hired to teach our children in the Makerspace.

Once we make all of our hires, we will have a very full staff designed to provide the best experience possible for our children. I'm looking forward to it and hope you are, too!

As a quick reminder while the weather continues to be beautiful: if your children will be playing on the playground after school, parents need to be the monitors. Please watch your children carefully and stay with them in the playground area.

Lastly, we got word from the Diocese that snacks will no longer be available after Monday. Children will have to bring their own snacks to school.

On Monday, our student council held a bake sale to help those in Ukraine. All students were able to visit the bake sale during lunch to pick out a tasty treat. Student council raised \$373, which will be forwarded to the Diocese of Covington and will be sent through the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for the Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe; 100% of the proceeds will go to the Ukraine.



#### Florence Y'Alls Game




