2022-2023 School Calendar

Good afternoon,

We hope you've had a great second week of school. It was great seeing everyone at Readyfest this past week. One of the things talked about was different St. Henry FUNraisers and FUNDraisers.

Over the years fundraising efforts have shifted, and will in the future in response to different needs. For the past several years (over a decade) the Crusader Royale has been our major fundraiser. We're very thankful for that and the people that have led it, but it seems that the Royale may have run its course. At this time we are not planning to have the Royale as we have in the past because there is not a leader for the event. We plan to replace the Royale with a social event aimed to bring people together, but not emphasize a fundraising goal.

Bingo has also been an important fundraiser for our school and parish, and everyone knows how well Bingo is doing. While Bingo is doing so well we want to continue to support it however we can.

We'll have other FUNDraisers - the boosters golf outing, CruGiving and the CruClub, for example, each targeting different audiences.

We also want to emphasize our FUNraisers. The boosters volleyball night (October 7 this year); PTO socials, including the Father / Daughter Dance and Mother / Son night and others are all examples. These events are a big part of what makes St. Henry the great place that it is, so we look forward to having them back fully this year.

I also mentioned updated information on noon dismissal this year. Below is a list of all the noon dismissals planned:

• Friday, September 30 - Safety training for staff. This noon dismissal was not originally scheduled. On this day staff will have a safety training from 12:30 - 3:30 put on by Kentucky State Police on what to do if we ever

experience a threat or active shooting event in our building.

- Monday, October 24 Parent / teacher conferences. Teachers have the opportunity to prepare for parent / teacher conferences during the afternoon and evening.
- Friday, February 3 End of Catholic School Week. The last day of Catholic Schools Week celebrates teachers. On this day teachers are treated to a lunch in celebration and honor for their hard work.
- Friday, May 26 last day of school. Say no more.

At this time, do not plan for aftercare to be available on noon dismissal days.

Another calendar note that I didn't get a chance to share is that we have an extra day built in this year. We always have inclement weather days, but the way the calendar worked out we were able to build in a floating day off this year. The plan is to potentially extend our March break from 3 to 4 days, or we could even use it for the day after the Super Bowl if the Bengals end up being good again this year.

Finally, aftercare could use some DVD's if anyone has some to donate. If you do, please drop them off in the office.

2022/2023 Boys & Girls Basketball Registration

Registrations for the 2022/2023 basketball season are open; **registration deadline is September 2, 2022**. Registration form link is below.

Registration fees: \$85.00 for third through eighth grade.

Registration fees: \$60.00 for first/second grade. We will NOT collect fees for first and second grades until we confirm that we have enough athletes to complete a full team. We will notify parents for first and second grade for fee collection.

Sixth grade boys will have two evenly divided teams to play in our hosted league. Tryouts will be held in September for one sixth grade competitive team.

Final registration numbers for seventh and eighth grade boys will determine if there will be a need for tryouts for an A team.

Final registration numbers will determine if we have to combine grades to create a team.




Volunteers Needed!
