Dear Middle School Families,

The SHDHS Fine Arts Department would like to invite your child to participate in the 2023 Creative Crusader Visual Art Competition.

Artwork may include ideas such as portraiture, still life, landscape, architecture, figure drawings, etc. The more creative, the better! There is no limit on subject matter. Students may use any media such as graphite, acrylic paint, watercolor, colored pencil, digital, textiles, or mixed media. 3D WORK IS ALSO ACCEPTED! All pieces must be submitted in person- no emailed or shared submissions will be accepted.

2D artwork must meet the following requirements*:

- Artwork may not be larger than 18x24.
- All artwork must have a clean 1" border (for displaying purposes). Please write the student's GRADE LEVEL ONLY ON THE FRONT OF THE PIECE in the bottom right hand corner of the border: failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- ON THE BACK OF THE PIECE include name of student, school name, and medium. Do not include any of this information on the front side of the piece to ensure that all judging is blind.

3D artwork must meet the following requirements*:

- Pieces may not be wider than 12" in diameter. No limit on height.
- Please include the student name, grade level, school, and medium on the BOTTOM of the piece

*Not meeting these requirements will disqualify the artwork from the competition. SHDHS is not responsible for any possible damage to artwork during the transportation of the pieces to and from the school office.

We must receive all artwork submissions in the SHDHS school office by Friday, January 6, 2023 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM. The artwork will be judged by a jury of four randomly selected teachers at SHDHS. All of the submissions will be displayed in the Wilson Family Art Gallery at SHDHS and the winners will be announced on January 12, 2023. The artwork will remain on display the following week in the gallery for our SHDHS students to appreciate and enjoy. All artwork and awards will be brought back to your grade school by the end of January with the exception of the 8th grade first place winner's piece.

The winners of the Creative Crusader Art Show will be awarded the following:

• The 1st place winners from grades 5, 6, and 7 will be awarded a certificate of achievement and an

SHDHS Art Club T-shirt

• The top three winners for grade 8 will be awarded a certificate of achievement, an SHDHS Art Club T-shirt, and a scholarship. All scholarships must be used at SHDHS and are a one-time award to be used during freshman year. First place: \$750, Second place: \$250, Third place: \$100.

Note: The 8th grade first place winner will also have their winning work framed and displayed at SHDHS for the 2022-2023 school year.
