Cold Weather Recess Guidelines

St. Henry has established the following guidelines for outdoor recess during cold months:

- We will have outdoor recess when the temperature is 32 degrees or above and the "feels like" temperature is 25 degrees or above.
- If the temperature is 31 degrees or below, and/or the feels like temperature is 24 degrees or below, there will be indoor recess.

This website will be checked at 10:45 AM and used to make the recess determination: www.weather.com. Occasionally, other factors may be considered when making the recess determination, e.g., wind on campus or ice on the parking lot.

Christ the King Sunday

We end the Church year with a bang on Christ the King Sunday — or, as we Catholics like to call it, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

In an age when kings and queens are better known through storybooks than as real life power-brokers, the feast might feel a little obscure for many Catholic kids. But it's worth taking a few minutes to highlight the feast for your kids. For one thing, the title "Christ the King" makes important connections to the Old Testament; it also directs our attention to Christ's triumph on the cross — and ultimately, at the end of time. For another, Christ is "king" in ways very different than ordinary human powerbrokers, and those differences can teach your kids something important about the Christian attitude toward leadership and power.

This week on Teaching Catholic Kids, you'll find some background on the feast, plus talking points and discussion questions to use with your kids, and a fun printable activity that invites your kids to compare the "King of the Universe" to today's superheroes.
