



KY's ProLife Constitutional Amendment - NOVEMBER 8, 2022

Amendment #2 Announcement

This November, Kentuckians will go to the polls once again. One of the choices facing them this year is a pro-life amendment to our State Constitution. Amendment #2 will explicitly affirm that the Kentucky Constitution contains no right to abortion or government funding of abortion.

If this amendment is adopted, questions about abortion policy will be left in the hands of our elected representatives in the state legislature. It will prevent us from having a Roe v. Wade-type decision at the state level.

There are many questions and misunderstandings about how this might affect women in difficult pregnancies with medical complications. The law currently recognizes a difference between medical treatment and elective abortion. And the legislature can, through the normal process, make any changes to the law that might be necessary in the future to fix anything that is unclear. Amendment #2 would do nothing to prevent or interfere with that process. It simply prevents the courts from declaring there is a constitutional right to abortion and striking down pro-life laws.

The Kentucky Catholic Bishops are strongly encouraging all Kentuckians to go to the polls on election day this year, go to the end of their ballots and vote 'YES' for Amendment #2. A "YES' vote on Amendment #2 is a vote for life!

As Catholics we know that protecting the sanctity of life is not a political stance, but a fundamental and moral foundation.

The Truth About **Abortion**

Abortion does not save women's lives.

Abortion is the **direct** and **intentional** killing of a child in the womb.

Abortion is never medically necessary. It does not treat or solve any pregnancy-related complication.

Outlawing abortion will not affect treatment for miscarriage.

Treatment for miscarriage and abortion is not the same thing.

There is a complete moral and legal difference between losing a child through miscarriage and intentionally taking the life of a child.

In the tragic case of miscarriage, surgery may be necessary—and is an ethical treatment—to remove the remains of an unborn child who has <u>already died</u>.

While the same surgery is done to perform an abortion, abortions impose this procedure on a *living child* with the **intention** of ending his or her life.

Women can get the lifesaving treatments they need—without abortion.

In rare cases, and in the absence of better alternatives, life-threatening maternal health conditions may require interventions that **indirectly** and **unintentionally** lead to the death of an unborn child. **Abortion restrictions will not prevent women from receiving these treatments.**

When the lives of mother and child are in immediate danger, the goal is to fight to save both patients. Effective treatments exist that seek to save the life of the mother and *never* to intentionally harm her unborn child. When a woman's life is at risk in pregnancy, preterm delivery may be used as a lifesaving medical intervention to preserve the life of both mother and child.¹

Ectopic pregnancies

result when an embryo implants outside the uterus—often in the fallopian tube. Sadly, such embryos cannot survive and this condition can pose serious risks to the mother. While ectopic pregnancies sometimes resolve naturally, interventions are often necessary. When done ethically, treatment for an ectopic pregnancy is not abortion. Ethical interventions include the removal of the damaged fallopian tube containing the embryo or, if embryo death has already occurred, medication can be used to resolve the ectopic pregnancy.

Bottom line: Abortion restrictions never prevent women from receiving life-saving treatment.²
