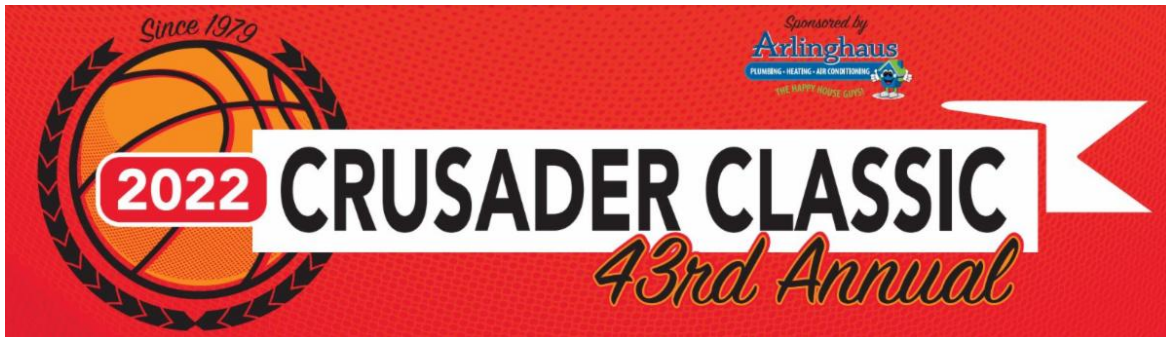
### Commemoration of the Faithful Departed

KY's ProLife Constitutional Amendment - NOVEMBER 8, 2022

### **How can I be sure to vote 'Yes for Life,' Nov. 8?**

Amendments are located at the bottom of the ballot. If you vote straight party, you will still need to go to the bottom of the ballot to cast your "Yes" vote on Kentucky Amendment #2. Kentucky Amendment #2 establishes that for the protection of human life, nothing in the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky can be interpreted to include a right to an abortion or state funding for abortion.

# 10 November Activities for Catholic Families



- 1. **Talk to your children about how we are all called to sainthood.** Work on self portraits and title them "Future Saint" or "Future Saint (Child's Name)" for All Saints Day on November 1<sup>st</sup>. - 2. **Attend Mass on All Saints Day!** It's a Holy Day of Obligation. (November 1<sup>st</sup>)
- 3. **All Souls Day is a day to remember all who have died.** To remember a special loved one, pray for their soul, visit a cemetery, or do a favorite activity you enjoyed with them. (November 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- 4. **Find an age appropriate science experiment or activity** to celebrate the feast day of Saint Albert the Great, the patron saint of scientists. (November 15<sup>th</sup>)
- 5. **Look for a program to buy Christmas gifts for a needy child** (in your community or across the world) in honor of the feast day of Saint Margaret of Scotland, who gave gifts and food to the poor and needy. (November 16<sup>th</sup>)
- 6. **Bake bread together to deliver to friends and neighbors** (especially those most in need of some extra love) in honor of the feast day of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary. (November 17<sup>th</sup>)
- 7. **Attend a musical performance or just have a family sing along/dance party** at home to honor Saint Cecilia, the patron saint of music. (November 22<sup>nd</sup>)
