Good afternoon,

It's certainly a busy October with plenty of information, dates and reminders included below.

First, we had a our safety training last Friday afternoon. Training like this is always very intense and emotional, and last week was no exception. In small groups as a staff we went through several different scenarios: first aid, tips for making an effective call to dispatch and then running, hiding or fighting depending on the threat level.

Following our safety training last week, we are having a school-wide safety assessment on October 17. Members of the Kentucky Center for School Safety will be on campus reviewing our policies, procedures, protocols and more. We're looking forward to getting their feedback and continuing to take steps to keep our campus safe and make it even safer.

Parent / teacher conferences are right around the corner, October 24. For most grades (K-5) families will sign up for a conference using Sycamore. Teachers will send out step-by-step instructions to sign up in their weekly newsletters, and middle school will send out a plan to sign up as well. Mrs. Goodridge can help anyone with their Sycamore login if necessary.

Grandparents' Day in the past has been logistically challenging because of our space constraints on campus. We no longer have space to park everyone that wants to attend, which is great to have so much family support! We're going to try something new this year and split Grandparents' Day into two sessions on one day, October 31. That's right, a Halloween treat that will allow grandparents to spend more time with their grandchildren in the school. We're going to have Grandparents' Day in the morning and then have Halloween parties in the afternoon. We are encouraging all students to stay at school throughout the day. More information, including how to sign up, will be forthcoming.

Finally, here are a few reminders to be aware of:

- The end of our first quarter is rapidly approaching next Thursday, October 13.
- We do not have school on Friday, October 14. Teachers will be meeting that day.
- Grades, along with beginning of year MAP scores, released on Friday, October 21.
- We have a noon dismissal on Monday, October 24 for parent / teacher conferences.






