## **School News**

Last weekend, our middle school academic team competed in the regional Governor's Cup competition. Our region consists of four districts that account for 18 middle schools in Kenton and Campbell County. At regionals, the competitors had placed in 1st-5th place in their respective district competition for subject area tests, or first or second at districts for quick recall and future problem



solvers. Our competitors who placed at regionals:


Our Future Problem Solvers, Harper Andrews, Molly Francis, Emma Lucius, and Chelsea Miller, coached by Suzi Francis, third place in regionals!

Although only the top two teams in quick recall and FPS advance to state, we are so

proud of how these kids competed.

Individual test takers who place in the top six at regionals advance to state. Congratulations to Luke Jankowski! Luke placed 6th in science and was the regional champion in social studies! He will participate in the state tournament in March in both science and social studies.

St. Henry placed fourth overall in the tournament! Going through the records, it appears third is the best we have ever done in quick recall at regionals—at least in the last 30 years. We last placed third in quick recall in regionals in 1997 (which is the year after this year's coaches graduated from St Henry Middle School)! We've only had three first place individual winners during that time including Luke this year, although our FPS team has been highly successful.


