

Lacrosse Camp Registration

We are excited to (finally!) open registration for the K-2 Spring Lacrosse league!! Please use this link to register <u>Lacrosse Camp Registration</u>.

The league will be hosted at St. Timothy School and will run for a total of six weeks on Friday evening, beginning March 24. The first two weeks (March 24 and 3t) will be a group practice/camp that will introduce rules and basic skills for each level. Games will begin Friday April 14 and conclude Friday May 19. There will be two divisions to choose from:

- **Soft Stick League** (K-2 girls), (K-1 boys) The games will be non-contact and played on a smaller field with "soft sticks."
- 2nd Grade In-House League This league will be played in full pads with modified checking rules. It is open to all 2nd grade boys and 1st grade boys that opt to play with full pads. Helmet, chest protector, gloves, elbow pads, and standard 42" lacrosse stick are required. We will have a limited number of sticks available to borrow.


