The idea was to host an All Star event celebrating those who played sports throughout their tenure at St. Henry. With the support of Principal Wolff, we'd like to carry this tradition forward.

We will be hosting the 8th Grade All Star Event on Saturday, March 18 from 6:30 - 8:00 p.m. at St. Henry's elementary gym.

PLEASE NOTE: This event is open to ALL 8th graders, regardless if they played a sport or not. We strongly encourage any student interested to attend, even if they would simply like to hang out with friends.


