The Carrie Williams Memorial Foundation was created by Carrie's family to honor her memory and her legacy of faith and education. Today, the Foundation is excited to share the Carrie Williams Memorial Scholarship application, taking a step closer to the mission of providing scholarships to children attending Catholic schools.

This year's inaugural scholarships will be given to two qualifying St. Henry Catholic School students to be applied to the 2023-2024 school year.

#### **Kremer Foundation Tuition Assistance**

St. Henry Catholic School has applied for a grant from the George and Mary Kremer Foundation, which will allow us to provide an alternative source of tuition assistance funding for all families, whether paying tuition at the Standard Tuition Rate or at the Active Church Member Tuition Rate, who meet certain family income limits:


The Kremer Foundation's maximum family income limit is \$57,409 per year for a household size of four (4) or fewer, but as increased by \$9,765 for each additional family member over the number of four residing in the household. For example, a family of five (5) has a maximum income limit of \$67,174 and a family of six (6) has a maximum income limit of \$76,939.

Kremer Foundation Grant Applications are available for pick up in the school office. Completed forms along with tax information are due back to Mrs. Lageman in the school no later than Tuesday, April 25 (no exceptions). In addition, you must also complete the information required to be entered at FACTS Management, which may be accessed by clicking here.
