Bingo Help Needed!

In an effort for our weekly bingo fundraiser to run effectively, more volunteers are required. School parents, parishioners and friends of St. Henry and St. Barbara are needed to fill monthly roles. Please consider committing to one Monday per month or more! Brief descriptions below:

<u>Paper Sales (week 4)</u>: Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can sell bingo papers to our patrons! Training is provided and fairly simply to understand. Duties include:

- Greet customers and help complete bingo order forms (explain the differences between the games and the different papers).
- Ring up paper order & provide totals to customers
- Collect money and provide change
- Select and provide the proper bingo papers to customers
- Answer general questions about game play

- Reconcile cash register with inventory (minimal spreadsheet knowledge required)
- This is a fun position where you get to meet our patrons and leave early! 5:30-7:30
 PM, this position allows for some sitting. Some bending and standing are required (to select papers for patrons).

<u>Monthly Pull Tab Sales (week 1, 2, or 3):</u> Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can help sell pull-tabs once a month to our patrons. Training is provided and fairly simply to understand. Duties include:

- Get your steps in walking around
- Accurately sell pull tabs and collect money from customers
- Provide outstanding customer service
- This is a part-time position that gets you home early, 5:00-7:30 PM

<u>Table Crew (week 3: 5:30-9:30 PM)</u>: Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can work the main banker table! Training is provided and fairly simply to understand. Duties include:

- Prepare cash for winning game payouts.
- Sell pull-tabs from the desk and discard small winning tickets
- This position allows for some standing but mostly a sitting position

Money Room (week 3: 8:00-10:00 PM): A low-key sitting position that is not customer facing. Duties include:

- Counting & totaling cash and checks accurately
- Prepare bank deposit slips

<u>Concession Sales (week 4: 5:30-9:00 PM)</u>: Bingo is looking for fun, friendly, smiling people who can sell concession items to our patrons! Training is provided and very simple to understand. Duties include:

- Serve delicious sub sandwiches, pizza, hot dogs, brats, & metts. Also, provide canned drinks, coffee, and snack items.
- Collect money & provide change.
- This position allows for some sitting; some bending and standing are required.


