The end of the school year is always busy for our Crusaders! **Fourth grade** students went to Pioneer Park to see firsthand about the water cycle, macroinvertebrates, and studied fish. Through interactive demonstrations and group activities, students learned about the Ohio River hydrologic cycle and the impact human activities have on the health of the river! The **fourth graders** also went on their traditional field trip to Frankfort, where they visited Kentucky's old Capitol building, wandered around Salato's Wildlife Education Center, and then toured the new Capitol building. Thanks to the Elsmere Fire Department, **third graders** learned about fire safety and concluded their week with a pizza party! **First graders** went to the Dinsmore Homestead in Boone County to learn about the Dinsmore family and activities they did 150 years ago. The students saw clothing from the time period, played games, and did chores, including washing and hanging clothes, grinding coffee, and more! Our **kindergarten** students have been learning about insects and visited the Krohn Conservatory to see the butterflies. **Junior high students** celebrated DNA Day by using marshmallows and toothpicks. **Seventh grade** students dissected frogs to see how the frog parts look very similar to those in humans.
