Also included is a postage paid envelope, if you choose to mail your forms. When mailing forms, be sure to allow enough lead time to assure delivery by July 5, 2023.

Parish Education Committee: Approved minutes from the May 23, 2023, meeting follows:

The Parish Education Commission (PEC) met on May 23, and welcomed a large contingent of school/parish members, who turned out because of the announcement that the school's principal would not be returning. The PEC would like to thank members of the school and parish community for attending the meeting and being interested in the PEC and parish/school. President Price opened the meeting by discussing what the PEC does and does not do, and then took questions from the crowd. After sharing what the role the PEC has or doesn't have with respect to the operations of the school, the PEC and public communicated a desire for more communication and transparency from the church/diocese/school to the parents, but also a voice in processes for school and parish members. While the public and the PEC talked about school matters, the public and PEC also discussed the desire for more information about parish and school finances. The PEC formed a plan to reach out to parents for feedback about a future principal so we can share that information with the search committee when it is
