New Roof on the Elementary School!

As many of you have pointed out, old buildings always need a certain amount of maintenance. Each building on our campus is aging and needs ongoing work, including our school buildings. I've always thought it makes a lot of sense to do a roof first, as it doesn't make much sense to do anything else if it's going to get wet from rain leaking in!

The elementary roof is extremely close to the "end of its service life," as the term goes. So replacement is underway! The roof should be finished in short order, hopefully before the start of school. If it is not, we ask your patience.

I want to make this plea also. We will be down about \$70,000 from our parish funds to make the roof happen. We do not have this money readily available and it will have to be drawn from our savings. That specification allows your donation to be exempt from diocesan assessment. The diocese does a lot for us and needs our support so they can support us. But it will be good to be able to put all the money you give right toward the school roof.
