Mrs. Wagner, principal, and school parents "chalked the walk" to encourage students to do their best on MAP testing throughout the week. MAP testing is used to measure and monitor individual growth in reading and math over time by identifying current skill levels and informing instructional strategies. Fourth graders learned about and created circuits in science class. Ben Brinkhaus, Winston Whitely, and Brandon Lorton were 3 out of 18 students from across the state of Kentucky to participate in the Civics Bee at the Kentucky State Fair. Winston finished in the top five out of over 600 applicants! Congratulations to all three! Second graders were exploring states of matter in science class. They used "oobleck," which is a mixture of cornstarch and water, that acts like both a liquid and solid. In fifth grade, students spent the week learning about nature and how authors are inspired when they are in nature. To help convince their classmates, students created Public Service Announcements about nature using skits, commercials, podcasts, and even catchy jingles and choreographed dances!


40 DAYS FOR LIFE - FALL 2025 September 24-November 2
