Dear Parents,

It has been a busy week at St. Henry with the Mumkin Sale, finishing up MAP testing, a tornado drill, and our Parent Volleyball Challenge this evening! Thank you to everyone who volunteered to help with the Mumkin Sale on Tuesday. Thanks to you, everything went very smoothly and we had everyone's orders ready to distribute in record time! We hope that we will see all of you at the Parent Volleyball Challenge this evening. This is a great community event and is an opportunity for you to get to know other parents and have some fun. The event kicks off with teachers vs. 8th graders at 3:45pm.

Last week and this week we completed our Fall MAP testing. As I shared previously, the data from this testing helps us determine how best to support our students as individuals and what they need as a class. Teachers use this information to shape their teaching and to assign students to groups in different areas. As a school, we had a goal of achieving in the 60th percentile across all 4 subject areas (Math, Reading, Language Usage, and Science). I am happy to report that we exceeded this goal! Our achievement scores were as follows...

- Math- 72nd percentile
- Reading- 67th percentile
- Language Usage- 73rd percentile
- Science- 71st percentile

These are great scores and as a reward, students will be able to be out of uniform next Tuesday, September 23!

I wanted to share some exciting news with you. We did receive approval from the Bishop to move forward with our Capital Campaign! The hope is that we will be able to raise between \$2-\$2.5 million to make improvements to our school and church. As we get further into this process you will receive information about what the money would be spent on and how you can get involved. Thank you for your support as we go through this process!



Your child does not need a bow to get started; we do have several for the team. If you have your own bow, that is great as well, it will need to be an NASP approved bow.




40 DAYS FOR LIFE - FALL 2025 September 24-November 2
