Dear Parents,

This week our students looked great for their school pictures on Tuesday and yesterday we started the hype for the first Bengals game of the season! We also started getting students in the mindset to take MAP tests next week.

MAP testing starts on Tuesday of next week and we have set a school goal of our achievement hitting at or above the 60th percentile, meaning we are performing better than 59% of schools taking MAP tests across the country. If we hit that goal then we will have an out of uniform day. We also have some things for our students throughout testing next week. We are asking parents to chalk our sidewalks before dismissal on Monday, September 8 and write encouraging messages for our students as they prepare for testing the following day. On Tuesday, it is National Teddy Bear Day, so we invite students to take their teddy bear to school to be a support during testing. On Wednesday we will have Smarties for all of our smarties, and on Thursday we will have music playing outside before school. We ask that you help your students be prepared by making sure they get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast. There is nothing else they need to do to prepare for these tests. All we ask is that they come in and do their best!

On Wednesday of this week, our school Safety Committee met to discuss ways that we can make our school safer, especially going to Mass, in light of recent events. We have decided to implement several things to help keep our community safe. Those items are below...

- The two side doors to church (parking lot side & ramp door) will be locked about 3 minutes before church starts.
- The front door to church will remain unlocked as Officer Doug is standing in the entry area throughout Mass and monitors those going in and out. It also allows the office staff to get in if they need to get to a student
- If students want to sit with a parent or grandparent at Mass, the procedure is as follows.
  - The parent/grandparent will need to come sign them out in the school office

by 8:15am.

- We will come over the PA and dismiss students who are sitting with a family member between 8:15-8:20 & they will walk over with their family member.
- The family member will walk them back over to the office and sign them in after Mass

These procedures will start next Friday, September 12. Reminders will be sent next week about the procedures for students sitting with parents at Mass. Thank you for your cooperation!






# Calling All Men!
