

Thanks to everyone who came out to play and/or supported our golf outing to benefit the athletic programs at St. Henry. The weather was perfect from tee off to the final hole.




CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Feasibility Study Results

- The study found that there is ample support from the community to warrant a capital campaign.
- Our campaign goal is recommended to be \$2-2.5 million

Where Faith Gathers, Foundations Matter

- Top priorities for our campaign include replacing the school's HVAC system, replacing the windows in the Jr. High building, replacing the roof on the church, and adding on two ADA-compliant bathrooms to the gym
- The second phase of the campaign would include putting down a new rubber playground surface (student-led request), updating the school's hot water system, and addressing the future use of Benedictine Hall
 - Originally we intended to knock down Benedictine Hall. However, we have investigated the cost to renovate the space and possible future uses. As a long-term investment, we hope to renovate the space for future use as a parish gathering space, a daycare center, with the potential of a small adoration chapel. We are excited about these possibilities!
- Phase three would address heating in the gym, replacing the gym floor, and making upgrades to parish A/C units.
