

Goodness is doing what is right and pleasing to God, even when it's hard. **Gentleness** means being kind and careful with your words and actions.




Crusader Snaps



Due to an upcoming planned retirement, St. Henry Parish is seeking a full time Business Manager. The position is a professional administrator, responsible for assisting the pastor with the stewardship of the physical and financial resources of the parish and its school. The Business Manager directs all business matters of parish operations, including oversight of the parish office staff, and is responsible for school tuition management. Understanding of accounting principles and previous accounting or bookkeeping experience is required. In addition to preparing the parish operating budget and cash flow forecasts, specific accounting duties include account reconciliations, supervision of cash disbursements and receipts, preparation of financial statements including the year-end close and the Annual Financial Report to the Diocese. Must possess good working knowledge of MS Excel and MS Word software.
